The annual Pre-Season polls (AP and USA Today/Coaches) have been released and to no one's surprise, Florida was picked No.1—to repeat as National Champion; and its third title in four campaigns.

Just how accurate has the AP, former UPI and USA Today Pre-Season choice for No.1 fared since the initial poll was released in 1950.

Before we look at this information; other questions have been raised: Are such polls necessary? Do they show that a team really is capable of winning the title—without playing a game? Should the pollsters wait till a few games of a current season be played before stating a team is worthy of the top spot?

While it is true no coach or sportswriter/broadcaster can see every game—even with today's technology; then how can they vote for a Top 25......good question!!

But, somehow it all gets done and in a timely manner—in time for weekly "discussions."

Since the initial Pre-Season Poll was released there has been 112 Pre-Season Polls —with only 22 times did the predicted No. 1 finish the season on top of the AP, UPI or USA Today's final poll.

That's not even 25%--18.03—to be exact.

The last No.2 in Pre-Season...to become National Champion: 2005 Texas—played in the Rose Bowl; site of the 2010 BCS National Championship Game.

Before that, in the AP Poll, was Florida in 1996—the year of the Gators' first crown; with Miami of Florida in 2001 picked second by the coaches and wound-up on top in the final selections.
