

SEC LISTED IN THE NATIONAL RECORDS

From the 2009 NCAA Football Records Book, pages 24-29

SEC teams year in and year out are among the most competitive of all schools playing at the top-level of NCAA Football—Bowl Subdivision.

College football statistics were initially compiled officially in 1937; and through the 1972 season, teams were considered Major College; 1973-2006, NCAA 1-A and since 2007, Bowl Subdivision.

And because of success of the teams in the SEC, a number of outstanding performances have been accomplished and thus, established records over the last 73 years.

--GAME--

❖ **TOTAL OFFENSE**

1 of 29 games where both teams gained over 600 yards
Nov. 22, 1997, Tennessee (695) and Kentucky (634).

❖ **RUSHING OFFENSE**

Became the 3rd of 5 teams to have 4 players Rush for over 100 Yards
Alabama vs Virginia Tech, Oct. 27, 1973: Jimmy Taylor, 142 yards; Wilbur Jackson, 138; Calvin Culliver, 127 and Richard Todd, 102.

❖ **PASSING OFFENSE**

Completing a min. of 15-24 Passes
Oct. 31, 1988, Tennessee completed 24 of 25 passes against South Carolina; 96.0%.

❖ **SCORING OFFENSE**

Most Missed FG
LSU missed 7 Field Goal attempts, Nov. 25, 1972, against Florida.

❖ **TURNOVERS**

Most turnovers
Georgia, Dec. 1, 1951, turned the ball over 13 times against Georgia Tech: 5 fumbles and 8 interceptions...also the record of a defensive team recovering the ball.

❖ **OVERTIME**

Periods Played
7 Arkansas defeated Ole Miss Nov. 3, 2001, 48-56...two years later; the Razorbacks defeated Kentucky, 71-63, Nov.1, 2003.

Number of Plays one and both teams

103 Kentucky vs Arkansas, Nov. 1, 2003; while the latter had 99 plays as the two teams combined for 202 plays. And further, these two teams combined for 47 in the 7 extra sessions.

DEFENSE:

Interception Return Yards: 240 Kentucky vs Ole Miss, Oct. 1, 1949 (6 picks).

Consecutive Opponent's Series Resulting in a Turnover: 7 Florida vs Florida State, Oct. 7, 1972: 4 fumbles lost and 3 interceptions—on the first 7 series of the game.

Both Teams Scoring a Defensive Extra-Point: Kentucky returned a fumble on a bad snap and LSU scored on a block kick, Oct, 17, 1998.

OFFENSE:

Highest Average per Gain on Completion: (Min. 225 Completions)...Florida, 17.1, 1996 (234-4007).

--SEASON--

- **Most turnovers (giveaways):** 6.1, Mississippi State, 1949; 55 in 9 games: 30 fumbles lost and 25 interceptions thrown.
- **Most turnovers (takeaways):** 57 Tennessee, 1970; 21 fumbles recovered and 36 passes intercepted by.
- **Total Touchdowns allowed per game:** 0.0, Tennessee, 1939. (tied)
- **Most Opponents FG blocked:** 6 Kentucky, 2004

--SEASON--

- **Consecutive Quarters shutout an opponent in the regular season:** 71 by Tennessee from the 2nd quarter vs LSU, Oct. 29, 1938 through the 2nd against Alabama, Oct. 19, 1940...Tennessee also hold the mark of 17 consecutive regular season shutouts.
- **Consecutive Scoreless ties:** 2 by Georgia Tech, 1938 vs Florida, Nov. 19 and Georgia, Nov. 26. Alabama, in 1954, also had 2 scoreless ties: vs Georgia, Oct. 30 and Nov. 6, against Tulane.
- **Most Time of Possession in a quarter:** 15:00 Auburn vs South Carolina, Sept. 28, 2006....30 plays for 136 yards.
